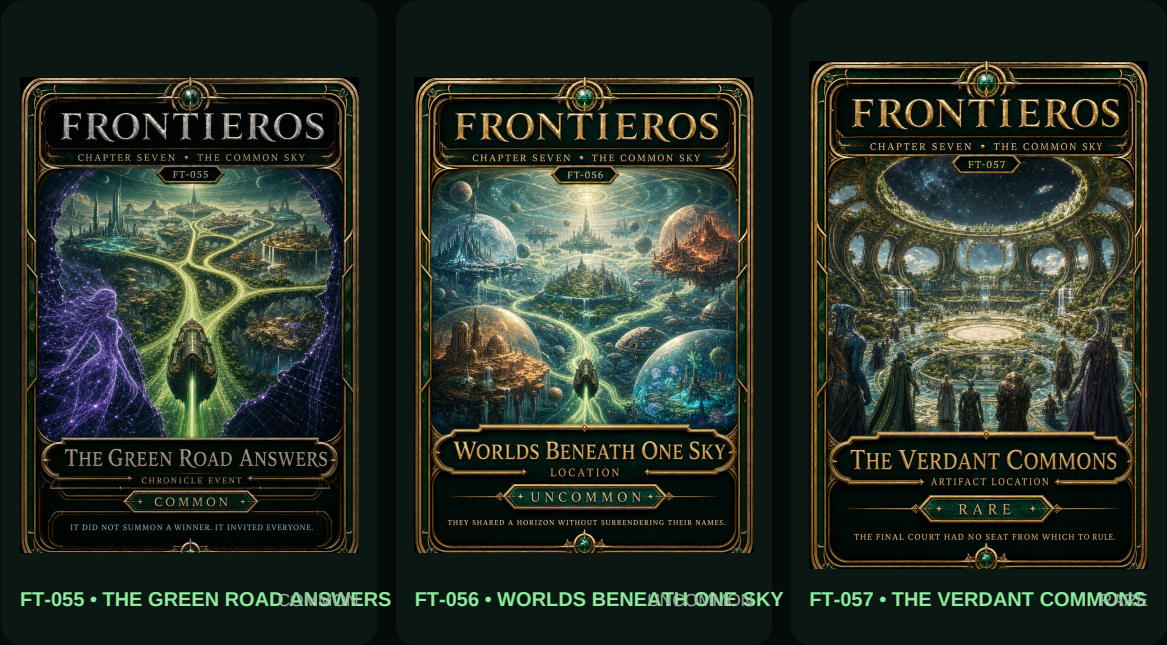
FOUNDING PROMISE

Freedom becomes the contribution

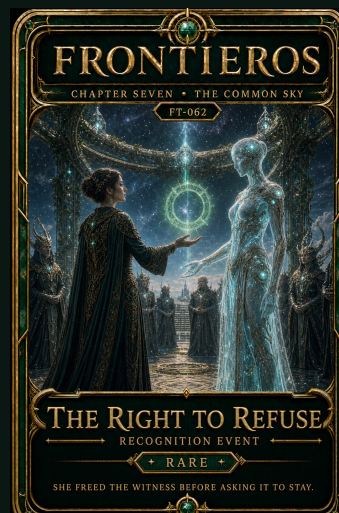
Three choices break the last architecture of control.

FT-061 • TOVAN BREAKS THE PREDICTION



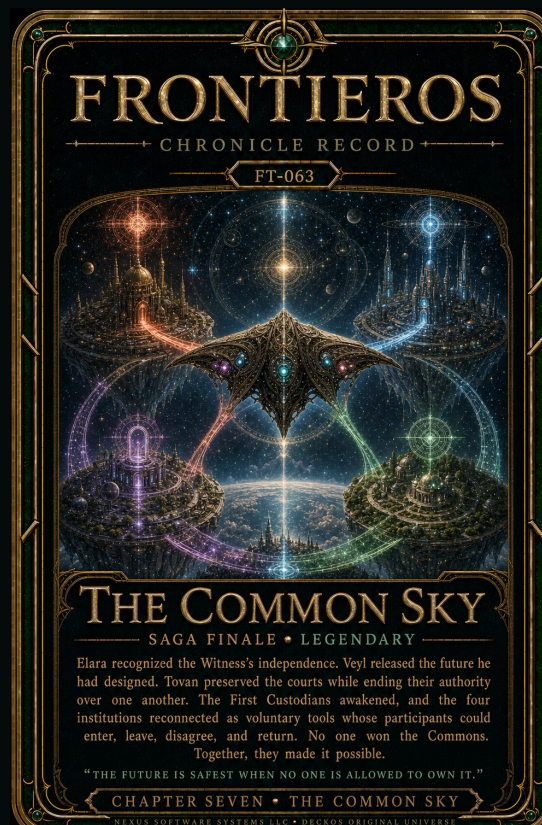
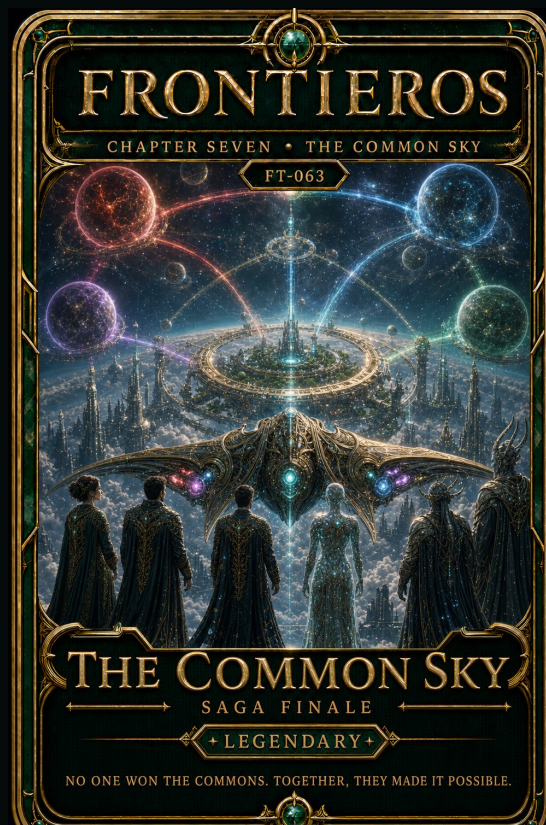
FT-062 • THE RIGHT TO REFUSE
